Missouri State Archives

- Created by the Missouri Legislature in 1965
- Repository for state records of permanent and historical value
- Holdings date from 1770 to the present
- State records, county and municipal records on microfilm; manuscript and reference collections.
- 336 million+ pages of paper; 830,000 photographs; 9,000 maps; 70,000 reels of county records on microfilm, 1,200 cubic feet of published state documents.

 Collections that demonstrate the diversity of Missouri's economic and agricultural activities.


<u>Cultures and Communities</u>

 Collections documenting the history of schools and education in Missouri.


<u>Exploration and Settlement</u>

 Collections documenting the executive, legislative, and judicial branches of government at the territorial, local, state, and federal levels.







Missouri State Archives: Pre-1910 Birth and Death Records

- Birth and Death Records were not required prior to 1910
- From 1883-1893 state law recommended that counties record births and deaths
- Database does not include all counties contact the Archives if the county you need is not listed
- Index and transcript only, no images
- Try the first few letters and spelling variations
